This Indenture made the 10th day of November in the year eighteen hundred and forty between Thomas Durn and Sarah Jane his wife of the County of Southampton County of the one part and Colton Carbrough of the County of Supra of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Thomas Durn and Sarah Jane his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and seven dollars and seventy five cents lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Colton Carbrough at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain sell and convey unto the said Colton Carbrough his heirs and assigns a certain piece tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by survey one hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows beginning at a corner on the road to Richard Prince then along his line N 33° W 22 poles N 29° W 70 poles to a Red oak a new made corner to Gamuel Runking along his line newly chopped N 31° E 89 poles to a maple on the catch of James King yards ac. along said line S 74° E 37 poles S 78° E 34 poles S 61° E 5 1/2 poles to a pine S 18° E 77 poles to an ash and a branch down said Branch adjoins Durns to a branch up said branch as it occurs to a black gum a corner to David Prince along his line S 3 1/4° W 24 poles S 8° W 36 poles to a pine S 85° E 59 poles to the Road and along said Road to the beginning together with all and singular the appurtenances and premises and the reversions and remainders and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof: To have and to hold the said tract piece or parcel of land with the tenements hereditamentally and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Colton Carbrough his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas Durn and Sarah Jane his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract piece or parcel of Land with all and singular the appurtenances and premises before mentioned unto the said Colton Carbrough his heirs and assigns forever the claim or claim of their the said Thomas Durn and Sarah Jane his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall well and lawfully warrant and prove against by these presents: Now Witnesseth that the said Thomas Durn and Sarah Jane his wife have herunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
