eighty three dollars and nineteen cents by the executing of this several Bonds to us in hand paid by the
said John A. Parsons at a before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged have bargained and sold unto by these presents unto the bargain and sell unto the said John
A. Parsons his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying on the South side of the River
leading from Jerusalem to Hagley Bridge it being the tract of land that the said Burwell Manly
possided in containing two hundred and ninety ^{three} and three quarter acres be the same more less
bounded by the lands of the heirs of Robert T. Magrawe dec^d and the Brantley land belonging to John
A. Turner and the lands of Peter Edwards; To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land
together with all the appurtenances belonging or in any way appertaining and all the proceeds hereof
for the only proper use of him the said John A. Parsons his heirs and assigns forever all the right and
title that we the said Peter Edwards Joseph T. Blaud and Edwin Harris as Commissioners are
intitled to and we the said Peter Edwards Joseph T. Blaud and Edwin Harris as Commissioners
do warrant and forever defend unto him the said John A. Parsons his heirs and assigns forever.

part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen hundred and forty four dollars
and fifty cents to him in hand paid by the said Edwards Butts the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have granted bargained and sold unto by these presents unto the said Briggs and his heirs and assigns
forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of
said and bounded as follows to wit: Commencing at a pine near the Colburn Road, between the land
and Richard Williams's land and running S 88° W 56 poles to a Red Oak a corner between
Butts and Richard Williams thence same course 92 poles to a pine a corner of the tract and
Edwards Butts thence S 55° E 121.28 a post Oak corner in E Butts line thence S 80° E 132.48 to a
Pine branch thence down said Branch to its junction with the Indian Branch thence same
the Indian branch to a black gum in Ethelred Briggs line thence S 88° E 35.32 to a
 Hickory corner in E. Drake's line thence S 72° E 51 poles to a white oak corner this tract E
Drake's and John Williams thence N 88° E 65 a poplar in branch near John Williams fence the
E 114.56 R Oak in Williams line thence N 87° E 70 poles to the Colburn Road thence same
