 in the County and State aforesaid being the same land which the said William Harris purchased of William
 Made and Phoebe his wife as by their deed of bargain and sale and is of record in the County Court of South
 Hampton No. containing by estimation fifty one acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows it com-
 mences at a point from near Zachariah Turners gate gate from thence a Northwesterly Course bounded by
 the land of Zachariah Turner to a red oak being a corner tree between the lands of the said Zachariah
 Turner and Nathan Turner from thence by the lands of Nathan Turner, David Turner and John Lewis
 up to a black hewd being a corner tree of the lands of the said John Lewis, David Turner and the poor house
 land from thence a straight line by the poor house land to the green pine first mentioned, To have
 and to hold the said tract or parcel of land to the said Patsy Griffen her heirs and assigns forever
 and the said William Harris and Eliza his wife their Executors and administrators the said tract or
 parcel of Land with all and every its appurtenances to her the said Patsy Griffen her heirs and assigns
 shall and will forever warrant and defend except the title or right which is considered doubtful.
