

7 witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of one dollar current money of Virginia to the said Samuel M. Pond in hand paid by the said John Drowry at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Samuel M. Pond hath given granted bargained sold alimited enfeoffed and confirmed unto these presents both give grant bargains sell alien enfeoff release and confirm unto the said John Drowry his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a pine near Mr. Woods gate thence along a line of Markers long to a corner between Kitchen and Hello thence along the lines of the old track (so that it will not touch the widows downer) and to contain two hundred acres out of said line with all and singular the appurtenances appertaining to the same and all the right title and interest of him the said Samuel M. Pond his heirs or assigns unto the said granted or hereby intended to be granted tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances unto the said John Drowry his heirs executors admors and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said John Drowry his heirs and assigns forever Upon this special trust moreover that the said John Drowry his heirs &c shall permit the said Samuel M. Pond to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said tract of Land and premises and take the profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the said debt for which the said Arthur A. Drowry is security either in whole or in part and upon this further trust that he the said John Drowry shall when he may be directed by the said Arthur A. Drowry his heirs executors or assigns expose to public sale to the highest bidder for cash after having advertised the time and place of sale at least ten days at two or more public places in this County and out of the money arising from the sale after satisfying the expenses attending the sale pay to the said Arthur A. Drowry his heirs or assigns the debt above named and the balance if any pay over to the said Samuel M. Pond his heirs or assigns but if the whole of the said debt shall be fully paid off and discharged before default of payment shall be made by the third Monday in January 1821 then this indenture to be void and to remain in full force and virtue.
