The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound George W Spicy has been appointed by the Court of Southampton County to serve as Constable within the said County to supply the vacancy created by the resignation of Alfred T Stephenson. Now if the said George W Spicy shall well and truly discharge the duties of the office of Constable in the said County during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void or else remain in full force and virtue.

Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty dollars Current Money of Virginia to her in hand paid or account to be paid by the said Ethelred Drake at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the the said Barbara Daughtry has bargained and sold and by these presents does bargain and sell unto the said Ethelred Drake his heirs and assigns during his life all that tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by survey One hundred and thirteen Acres more or less held by her the said Barbara Daughtry as Covert in the land belonging to the estate of Joseph Drury (whose widow she was) and bounded as follows A.C. by the Indian branch N.W. by that portion of Land allotted to Benjamin Drury one of the heirs S.W. by the lands of Jere Cobb and South by Jere Cobb together with all and singular the houses Orchard &c. thereto belonging the grange and other tenements and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the Tenements &c. above mentioned as bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Ethelred Drake his heirs and assigns for and during the lifetime of the said Barbara Daughtry and the said Barbara Daughtry for herself and her heirs the said tract of Land with all and
