This Indenture made this 16th December 1820 between Ethelred Drake of the first part Gilbert Vick
 trustee of the second part and Vick and Drury of the third part Creditors all of the County of Southampton
 and State of New York Witness that the said Ethelred Drake for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar
 to him in hand paid by the said Gilbert Vick at and before the making and delivery of these presents
 the right whereof is hereby acknowledged as well as the further consideration of the said Ethelred
 Drake being justly indebted to the said Vick and Drury in the just and full sum of Seventy six
 dollars and 72 Cents due by bond bearing date with these indentures, Witness that the said Ethel-
 red Drake is willing to secure the said Ethelred Drake and Amos Drury which is the sole object of
 of these presents hath granted bargained and sold and conveyed unto the said Gilbert Vick
 his heirs Executors or assigns the following property as follows my interest in the life estate which
 I purchased of Mrs Daughtery 1 Bay Horse, stock of hogs and cattle crop of cord mow in the City and
 foder. I convey unto the said Gilbert Vick his heirs Executors or assigns the said land and prop-
 erty forever but upon this special trust and condition that the said Gilbert Vick his heirs or
 assigns being requested by the said Vick and Drury their heirs or shall make sale of the above
 mentioned property at public for the best price that can be obtained for the same any time
 after the 10th of Decr. 1820 by giving ten days public notice at the Court house over of the
 County aforesaid previous to the day of sale of sd property and with the money arising from
 the said sales first pay the sd Vick and Drury their debt and all costs which may accrue in
 making sales of the said property within mentioned then pay to Ethelred Drake the over
 plus if any and the said Ethelred Drake for himself his heirs and assigns do warrant the
 right and title to the said property herein mentioned for the purpose aforesaid do warrant and
 forever defend the right again any lawful claim or claim whatsoever and the said Gilbert
 Vick for himself his heirs and assigns do agree to make sale of the above mentioned property
 any time when requested by the said Vick and Drury their heirs Executors or assigns. In

S. Westbrooke and wife Nancy P. hath this day for and in consideration of the sum of eight thousand
dollars good and lawful money to them in hand paid at and before the making and delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained confirmed and delivered
and by these presents doth grant bargain sell confirmed and deliver unto the said Thomas H. Westbrooke
to have and his heirs forever One certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of
Southampton in the State of Virginia supposed to be one hundred and sixty acres to the same more or less
and bounded as follows (viz) beginning at the corner place in 1817 of James Lewis Parsons Westbrooke etc
