This indenture made and entered into this 22nd day of December in the year 1820 between Thomas G Jones and Martha his wife of the one part and Anthony N Williams and John A Turner of the other part all of the County of Southampton: Witnesseth that the said Thomas G Jones and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand dollars to them in hand paid or deemed to be paid at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Anthony N Williams and John A Turner a certain lot or piece of land situate in and adjacent to the Town of Jerusalem in the County aforesaid and containing by recent survey seven and two thirds acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at the corner of the piazza of the house now occupied by the said Thomas G Jones as a Tavern a corner in the public Land thence N 16° 11 22.2 poles up the main street to a corner in James N Sobell thence S 67° 02.8 poles a corner in James N Sobell and Thomas G Jones thence S 35° 04.8 poles to a subpines plot a corner in Thomas G Jones and Fidelity S. Johnson thence S 52° 14 poles to a lightwood plot at the corner of the New house thence S 23° 02.5 poles to a stone line thence S 69° 18.6 poles to a small house built for Joshua Hurrell thence S 23° 02.32 poles to a lightwood plot a corner in Fidelity S. Johnson and Thomas G Jones thence a straight line to the beginning together with all the buildings and improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereof of every description also twenty beds and all the household and kitchen furniture of every description attached to appertaining or belonging to the Tavern of the said Thomas G Jones and Martha his wife in the Town of Jerusalem. To have and to hold the said lot or piece of land with all the buildings and improvements thereon and the appurtenances of every kind thereto belonging also the household and kitchen furniture of every kind and description attached to appertaining or belonging to the Tavern of the said Thomas G Jones in the Town of Jerusalem to them the said Anthony N Williams and John A Turner their heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of them the said Anthony N Williams and John A Turner their heirs and assigns forever. And the said Thomas G Jones and Martha his wife for themselves their heirs executors and administrators doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Anthony N Williams and John A Turner their heirs and assigns that they the said Thomas G Jones and Martha his wife and their heirs the said lot or piece of land with the buildings and improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereof of every description and the household and kitchen furniture before mentioned unto them the said Anthony N Williams and John A Turner their heirs and assigns against them the said Thomas G Jones and Martha his wife and their heirs and against all persons whatsoever shall and will by these presents forever warrant and defend. Now Witness whereof the said Thomas G Jones and Martha his wife hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year before written.
