Edwards at the sealing and delivery of these presents have granted bargained and sold and by these
presents doth grant bargain and sell unto G. R. Edwards his heirs &c forever a certain tract or part
of Land containing one hundred and five acres lying on the east side of Flagg Bury and
bounded by certain marks which will appear by reference to a deed made good Richard & Williams
