This Indenture made the 30th day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty between Thomas G Jones and Martha L his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and James M Gilbert of the said County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Thomas G Jones and Martha L his wife in consideration of One Cent of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said James M Gilbert at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold unto by these presents do and covenants of them doth bargain and sell unto the said James M Gilbert his heirs and assigns a certain Trust or Set of Land with the appurtenances situate lying and being in the County of Southampton containing One acre more or less and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at the corner of the said Gilbert's lot at the road that leads from Jamestown to Petersburg and along the said Gilbert's line a north East Course to the middle of a pond thence down the said Pond along Nicholas M Gilbert's line to the said Road thence down the said Road to the beginning together with all lands, tenements, appurtenances and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging or appurtening or with the same in any way or accepted, reputed, taken or known as parts thereof or as belonging to the same or any part thereof and the revenues and issuing, remainder, issue and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said Trust or Set of Land with the tenements, hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with way of their right, memory and appurtenances unto the
