This Indenture made and entered into this 30th day of December A.D. 1820 between Thomas C Jones and Marthas his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Firding I Mahomed of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas C Jones and Marthas his wife in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Firding I Mahomed the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Firding I Mahomed his heirs and assigns a certain part of a certain house and lot situate in the Town of Jerusalem in the County aforesaid bounded and described as follows beginning on the public square or street directly opposite the center of the front door of the house known as the Kells house running thence along the public square or street westerly northerly twenty nine feet to the South west corner of a house lately occupied by Samuel J Douglas in an office thence in a line by or with the South end of said house or office at right angles and Easterly course to a line between said Firding I Mahomed (formerly barlugs) and the premises hereby intended to be conveyed thence along said Firding I Mahomed (formerly barlugs) and the premises hereby intended to be conveyed thence along said line a southerly course to a corner between said F. I. Mahomed (formerly barlugs) and the said premises opposite to and within about ten or eleven feet from the center of the back or rear door of the aforesaid house called the Kells thence through the center of the house above and below stairs to the beginning containing by estimation of an acre more or less. Also another lot or piece of land being a part of the aforesaid lot No 18 and is the same which was allotted to Edwin Richy by the Commissioners who made divisions of lots No 18, 19 between Robert Goodwin the heir of Henry Swaly and the said Edwin Richy all of which will be more fully understood by reference to the Commissioners report of said division made in the year 1824 and containing by estimation about one fifth of an acre to be the same more or less together with all and singular the privileges and appurtenances to the said lots or pieces of land and the part of the house above mentioned in anywise appertaining or belonging. To have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said Firding I Mahomed his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Thomas C Jones for himself his heirs execs and administrators do covenant with the said Firding I Mahomed his heirs and assigns that the said Jones and his heirs execs and admors shall warrant and defend the before granted premises to the said Firding I Mahomed his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
