Witnesseth that the said William Parker and Susan his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said George B Bury and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and which said land was formerly allotted to the said Susan Parker formerly Nicholson in the land of her father Peter Nicholson &c in the County of Southampton (the several lands of said Nicholson not included) To have and to hold the said land above mentioned and described to the said George B Bury his heirs and assigns forever. And the said William Parker and Susan his wife for themselves their heirs heirs and assigns defend the right and title to the above granted premises to the said George B Bury his heirs and assigns forever.
