Witnesseth that the said William Parker and Gwen his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said George Bray and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and which said land was to his Sister allotted to the said Gwen Parker formerly Nicholson in the land of her father Rich Nicholson deceased in the County of Southampton (the other land of said Nicholson not included) To have and to hold the said land above mentioned and described to the said George Bray his heirs and assigns forever. And the said William Parker and Gwen his wife for themselves their heirs and assigns do warrant and forever defend the right and title to the above granted, promising to the said George Bray his heirs and assigns forever.
