Witnesseth that the said Louisa Nicholson for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to her in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargain and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said George B Gury and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and which said Land was allotted to the said Louisa Nicholson in the sum of her father With Nicholson dec'd in the County of Southampton (the down Land of Mrs Nicholson not included) To have and to hold the said Land above mentioned and described to the said George B Gury his heirs and assigns forever, And the said Louisa Nicholson for herself her heirs executors and administrators do warrant and defend the right and title to the above granted premises to the said George B Gury his heirs and assigns forever.
