This Indenture made this 2nd day of Nov^r in the year One Thousand eight hundred and Forty
 between John H Booth and Dorothy his wife of the one part, and Henry Booth of the other part
 and both of the County of Southampton, Minisepeth that for and in Consideration of the premises to
 wit: One hundred and ninety Acres of Land More or less bounded West by the lands of Edwin Travis
 North and East by John H Booth South by William Mellons and the lands of Thomas Gray did the
 said John H Booth and Dorothy his wife do hereby agree to give to the said Henry Booth their Davis
 Tract of Land, Containing One hundred and thirty One acre with the exception of the land lying
 in the North fork of the Colburn and Whig Roads supposed to be about four acres, and also two
 hundred and seventy five dollars to him the said Henry Booth in full and paid or secured to be paid
 at or before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 and the said John H Booth and Dorothy his wife has and do hereby relinquish all claim
 right or title to the before mentioned tract of Land and by these presents do warrant and
 forever defend the title in them vested against the claim or claims of them and their heirs
 executors and administrators and against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons
 whatsoever. In Witness whereof they the said John H Booth and Dorothy his wife has hereunto
