Upon trust provisoriell^y that the said Lambert Watkins his heirs &c shall permit said E P Branch to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of Land until the 2^d day of Sept^r 1830 after which time shall have expired if the said Mrs Branch has not paid off and discharged the said debt of two hundred and Forty three dollars and eighty seven cent^s dollars with all legal expences the said Lambert Watkins shall at the request of the said Branch and Sons proceed to make sale of the said Land to the highest bidder for cash after advertising at least ten days and out of the money arising therefrom shall after satisfying the debt herefore named and all other expences attending such sale shall pay to the said Elizabeth P Branch her heirs &c the balance if any.
