This Indenture made this 12th day of January in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and Forty between Willis Bradshaw of the one part and Isaac Holt of the other parts both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Willis Bradshaw in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars of Lawful Money of Virginia to him in hand paid or secured to be paid at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold unto by these presents with bargain and sell unto the said Isaac Holt his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid and on the south west side of the said Willis Bradshaw's Mill pond containing by estimation One hundred acres more or less beginning at a pine in the edge of the said Mill pond a corner tree of Henchey McElmays line thence a line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree in Polly Vicks line standing near the old dead branch thence down said branch to the Merry branch thence down the said Merry branch to the main run of franky thence up the said franky branch to the first station. Together with all and singular the houses out houses edifices buildings gardens gardeners orchards ways waters and water courses lands and Tenements profits commodities advantages emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging or in any way appertaining to the same or any part or parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and premises herein before mentioned or intended to be sold and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Isaac Holt his heirs and assigns forever And the said Willis Bradshaw for himself his heirs the said land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Isaac Holt his heirs and assigns forever free from the claims or claims of him the said Willis Bradshaw or his heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
