 that the said Edward M. Shield and his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred
 and fifty dollars to them in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged hath bargained
 and sold and conveyed and by these presents doth bargain sell and convey unto the said Polly Brindle
 a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows
 by Edward Spivy and by the Smithfield Road and by Thaddeus Boykin and Harrison Jones
 and Richard Kellow and Sumner M. Bone. To have and to hold the said tract of Land together
 with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any way
 appertaining unto the said Polly Brindle and her heirs forever that the said Edward M. Shield and
 his wife doth by these presents warrant and defend the right and title of the said tract or parcel of
 Land with all the the appurtenances therunto belonging unto her the said Polly Brindle her heirs
 and assigns against the lawful claims or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever.

 witness that whereas the said Patrick B. Hurwell is now confined in the jail of Salisbury
 County by virtue of an execution in favor of Edmund B. Hurwell Executor of Royal Hurwell dec^d
 and the said Patrick B. Hurwell being desirous of availing himself of the benefit of the
 insolvent law. Now therefore for and in consideration of the premises the said Patrick
 B. Hurwell has granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell
 unto the said Thomas Pastow Shff of Southampton aforesaid all that tract of Land in said
 County of Southampton containing about two hundred and fifty two acres to the same more or
 less received by the said Patrick B. Hurwell in a division between the divisions of Royal Hurwell
