 between Edward M. Shield and his wife of the one part and Polly Brittle of the other part. Witnessed
 that the said Edward M. Shield and his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred
 and thirty dollars to them in hands paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged full payment
 and sold and conveyed and by these presents doth bargain sell and convey unto the said Polly Brittle
 a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows
 by Edward Spivey and by the Smithfield Road and by Phanucks Boykin and Harrison Lynn
 and Richard Bellour and Samuel M. Pond. To have and to hold the said tract of Land together
 with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise
 appertaining and the reversion and reversionary remainder and reversionary rents issues and profits
 thereof unto her the said Polly Brittle and her heirs forever that the said Edward M. Shield and
 his wife doth by these presents warrant and defend the right and title of the said tract of land
 with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto her the said Polly Brittle her heirs
 and assigns against the lawful claims or claims of all and every person or persons whatever.

 witnesseth that whereas the said Patrick B. Hawell is now confined in the jail of Isle of Wight
 County by virtue of an execution in favor of Parsons & Hawell executors of Edward Hawell deceased
 and the said Patrick B. Hawell being desirous of availing himself of the benefit of the
 insolvent debt. Now therefore for and in Consideration of the premises the said Patrick
 B. Hawell has granted bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargains and sells
 unto the said Thomas Preston Shiff of Southampton aforesaid all that tract of land in said
 County of Southampton containing about two hundred and sixty two acres to the same more or
 less received by the said Patrick B. Hawell in a division between the executors of Edward Hawell
