This Indenture made and entered into this the 28th day of October 1839 between Riddick Durand and Mary his
wife formerly Mary Rockwell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Clement
Rockwell of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Riddick Durand and Mary
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and seventy five dollars to them in hand
paid by the said Clement Rockwell at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell
unto the said Clement Rockwell his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing seventy five
acres be the same more or less lying and being in Saint Lukes Parish in the County aforesaid being the part allotted
to the said Mary as her portion of the lands of her deceased Father John Rockwell of the boundaries whereof may
be fully seen by reference to the Report of the Commissioners and the plat accompanying the same returned
to the County Court of Southampton at the November Term 1832 To have and to hold the said tract or
parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Clement Rockwell his heirs and
assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Clement Rockwell his heirs and assigns forever. And
the said Riddick Durand and Mary his wife for themselves their heirs executors and administrators
do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Clement Rockwell his heirs and assigns that they the
said Riddick Durand and Mary his wife and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land with its appur-
tenances unto him the said Clement Rockwell his heirs and assigns against them the said Riddick Durand
and Mary his wife and against all persons whomsoever shall and will forever by these presents covenant
