This indenture made the twelfth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two between Jesse Parker of the one part and Alfred Cobb of the other part both of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Jesse Parker for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Alfred Cobb at and before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) he the said Jesse Parker hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents with grant bargain and sell unto the said Alfred Cobb a certain tract or parcel of Land in the County and State aforesaid and bounded as follows beginning at a black quind in the road leading from South Day to Monroe Ferry in the late Henry Sanders line and bounded East by said Road South by the land of Eliza Davison and West and North by the said Davison and the heirs of the said Henry Sanders dec. Containing fifty acres more or less together with all and singular the appurtenances and appurtenances remaining and remaining yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said Tract of Land unto the said Alfred Cobb for ever and the said Jesse Parker for himself and his heirs the said Tract or parcel of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Alfred Cobb his heirs and assigns fore from the claim of him the said Jesse Parker his heirs and assigns and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
