 which are now due and owing or which may hereafter become due or which may be or has been due
 owed to me by any person or persons living in the said State of Virginia hereby empowering him
 to receive due for and demand all moneys due or demands due and owing to me in the said State
 of Virginia and to have use and take all lawful means and ways in my name or otherwise
 for the recovery thereof by attachment, writs, distress or otherwise and compound and agree for the
 same for me and in my name to make seal and deliver and do all things lawful things what-
 soever concerning the premises as fully and completely as I myself could or might do were I personally
 present at the doing thereof relieving and confirming and by these presents allowing whatsoever my
 said attorney shall in my name lawfully do or cause to be done in and about the premises by virtue of
