This Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars in hand paid by the said Emma Beal to him the said Jacob Barnes at and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in consideration of which he the said Jacob Barnes doth hereby grant bargain and sell unto her the said Emma Beal one certain lot or parcel of land by and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded by the lands of the following named persons to wit: William W Butler, Patience Vick, Josiah Vick, John L Turner and Benjamin Butard and supposed to contain about thirty acres of Land this is to the parties herein embodied not whether there be more or less. It have and to hold the said Parcel of Land and every part and parcel thereof with all the right title interest and estate which he the said Jacob Barnes has heretofore held in and to the said Land described above to her the said Emma Beal her heirs and assigns forever free from the claim of him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns and also free from the claim of all and every person and persons whomsoever and by these presents will and do warrant and defend the title of in and to said Land in fee simple to her the said Emma Beal her heirs and assigns forever.
