Person by Wm L. Gwinn Trustee by a deed bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> day of July 1816 and duly recorded in  
the Clerk's Office of Southampton as by reference to which will more fully appear containing two hun-  
dred and ten acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Rebecca O. Gwinn and  
Children, James Jones, Henry Harrison, David Harrison, Est. and Benjamin Travis Est. together  
with all improvements of every description thereto attached or in any way belonging and the said John  
A. Person doth for himself his heirs &c. with the exception of the dower right of Rutharine Harrison  
the widow of the late Ben<sup>g</sup>. Harrison it being her life right to one third of said land claimed by her

Turner his heirs and assigns against me the said James M. Pond my heirs and assigns  
and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall warrant and forever
