unto him the said James D Westbrook his heirs and assigns ^{forever} to the only proper use and benefit of

wife doth for themselves their heirs and assigns warrant and forewarn defend the one third part of the
said Land unto the said James D Westbrook his heirs executors and administrators forever against the
right title claim or interest of all and every other person or persons at the death of said Lucy Lucy formerly

Westbrook his heirs or assigns a certain tract of Land containing one hundred and four acres more or less bounded
North by Simon D Westbrook's land East by Joseph T Blaauw west by William B Westbrook. To have and to
hold the said tract of Land together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging from the
