This Indenture made and entered into this second day of January eighteen hundred and forty one between Martha D. Trivant wife of Theodore Trivant of the first part and Henry B. Vaughan of the second part Witnesseth that the said Martha D. Trivant for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to her in hand paid by the said Henry B. Vaughan at the instant and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell, enfeoff and convey to the said Henry B. Vaughan his heirs and assigns forever all right title and interest whatever which she the said Martha D. Trivant has in and to a tract of land purchased by her of Lewis Morrell lying in the Indian woods and containing one hundred and forty acres it being the same tract was allotted to Aaron & Henry Turner and adjoining the lands formerly allotted to William L. Boyzeman and Esch Turner the boundaries of which will more fully appear by reference to the Indian plat or the original deed from Aaron and Henry Turner to Lewis Morrell &c. To have and to hold the same with ^{all} the appurtenances to the said Henry B. Vaughan his heirs and assigns forever from the claims or claims of all persons whatever. And the said Martha D. Trivant for herself hereof her heirs &c. hereby covenants that the title to the same she will warrant and defend.
