delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold
and by these presents doth grant bargains and sell, release and convey to the said Henry B. Vaughan his
heirs and assigns forever all right title and interest whatever which she the said Martha D. Trigunt
has in and to a tract of land purchased by her of Lewis Morell lying in the Indian Woods and
containing One hundred and forty acres it being the same that was allotted to Green of Henry
Turner and adjoining the lands formerly allotted to William & Boyerman and Edith Turner the
boundaries of which will more fully appear by reference to the Indian plat or the original deed
from Green and Henry Turner to Lewis Morell ^{to the} ^{all} power. To have and to hold the same with its appur-
tenances to the said Henry B. Vaughan his heirs and assigns forever free from all claims or claims
of all persons whatsoever. And the said Martha D. Trigunt for herself her heirs & assigns hereby covenants
that the title to the same she will warrant and defend. In Testimony whereof she
