

Williams, & Known all men by these presents that we John Williams, Patsy Williams and Sally Williams
 to Members of the Mohawk Tribe of Indians of the first part and James G French of the second
 part Witnesse that the said John Williams to whom has been allotted by the Trustees in fee simple
 under an order of the County Court of Southampton Ninety eight and $\frac{1}{4}$ acres of Land known as
 the Indian plat as No 3 in laying off the Indian outlet the said Patsy Williams to whom was
 allotted under the said Order and at the same time there was allotted eighty six and $\frac{1}{4}$ acres known as
 the plat as No 2 and adjoining the piece last described and the said Patsy Williams to whom was
 allotted eighty six and $\frac{1}{4}$ acres at the same time and under the same order of court known as
 the plat as no 3 each of these pieces adjoining the lands of Harry Vaughan now deceased and
 being laid off on the Land known as the Indian outlet and being
 allotted to them in view of all their interest in the landed estate held by the trustees for the
 benefit of the Mohawk Indians. This Indenture witnesseth that the said John Williams,
 Patsy Williams and Sally Williams for and in Consideration of the sum of one thousand
 and eighty three dollars which is four dollars per acre. The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 to wit. The said John Williams the sum of three hundred and seventy four dollars
 and the said Sally Williams and Patsy Williams the sum of three hundred and forty
 five dollars have granted bargained and sold and by these presents the said John Patsy
 and Sally Williams doth grant bargain and sell unto the said James G French his heirs
 & forever all right title interest and claim whatever which they the said John, Patsy and
 Sally Williams and have in and to the Land allotted them as before described. To have and
 to hold the said several tracts herin conveyed free from the claims of each one of us and
 of all other persons whatever. In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals
