James W. Parker one of the witnesses thereto. And having been before proved in the office on the 18th
day of the same month by Henry B. Vaughan and Daniel N. Dronge two other witnesses thereto and
admitted to Record.

Tsks G. R. Edwards G.C.

This Indenture made and entered into this 22nd day of December A.D. 1830 between Pittston R.
Edwards of the one part and James G French of the other part both of the County of Southampton
Wiltshire that the said Edwards by Virtue of the power vested in him by a certain deed of Trust executed
to him by Theodore Trigant for the benefit of James G French on the 20th day of March 1830 and admitted
to record in the Clerks Office of Southampton County did this day (the 22nd day of December 1830)
reasonable notice of the time and place of sale having been given - set up and sold at public auction to
the highest bidder a certain tract or parcel of Land containing about fifty acres lying in the Indian
woodly and being the same which the said Trigant purchased of Mary Williams an Indian and
which Land is knowned as the Indians plot as No 5 and James G French became the purchaser of
the said tract or parcel of Land (he being the highest bidder) for the sum of two hundred and
Twenty dollars. Now therefore the said Pittston R Edwards for and in Consideration of the aforesaid
sum of two hundred and Twenty dollars to him cash in hand paid by the said James G French
before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
bargained and sold and do hereby bargain sell grant and Convey unto the said James G French
his heirs and assigns the above described tract or parcel of Land and promises with every of its
appurtenances To have and To hold the same unto the said James G French his heirs and
assigns forever. and the said Edwards hereby warrants and defends the title to the premises hereby
Conveyed unto the said James G French his heirs and assigns against himself the said Edwards
and those claiming under him but against the claim of no other person or persons. In Testimony

day and year first above written.
