all danger of having any thing to pay for him at the suit of the said Lewis H Branch This Indenture witnesseth
that for and in consideration of his willingness to prevent the above named William D Wood
and/or Patrick H Rolling Marmaduke H Branch and John A Hill from incurring any loss by him in the
settlement of the aforesaid Estate of Lewis H Branch and for the further sum of One dollar to him in
paid Trustee hand paid by the above mentioned Eli Loker at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said John H Booth and Dorothy his wife have granted bar-
gained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Eli Loker his heirs
and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton containing
four hundred and Twenty five acres and bounded as follows To by Peter Booths Land and a house upon branch
west by Willis Hollings Patrick H Rolling and Edwin Travers and Patsey Booth now Edwin Morris's
Land to by Patrick H Rolling Land and East by the Rightwood swamp together with all and singular
the premises and appurtenances thereunto belonging and all the right title and interest of them the said
John H Booth and Dorothy his wife in and to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted parcel of
Land and premises and also the following slaves to wit Travers and Dawson To have and to hold
the said hereby granted tract or parcel of Land and premises unto the said Eli Loker his heirs
executors or assigns forever and also the before mentioned property to wit Travers and Dawson
Upon such notwithstanding that the said Eli Loker shall pay to the said John H Booth and
Dorothy his wife to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said Land and premises and also
the aforesaid property hereby conveyed to wit Travers and Dawson to their only proper use and the
property thereof until default be made on the settlement of the aforesaid Estate of Lewis H Branch
and the entire discharge of all claims against him as donee of Lewis H Branch and so soon after
such default shall be made known by the Sheriff who now has the settlement of the same by
the said Eli Loker shall at the request of the said William D Wood Patrick H Rolling Marmaduke
H Branch and John A Hill after having given ten days notice of the same at two or more
Public places in the neighbourhood sell to the highest bidder on such terms as the said
Borrowers may request the above mentioned Land and appurtenances as well as the afore-
mentioned property above named or as much thereof as shall pay the costs of carrying this
deed into effect and also the debt that shall be found due the Estate of Lewis H Branch
and the balance if any shall pay over to the said John H Booth or assigns this this Indenture
