This Indenture made this 5th day of March 1841 between Benjamin of the first part Thugaz
 Lewis of the second part Samuel H. Pond John A. Hill and James H. H. Pond of the third part. Whereas
 the said Benjamin Branch is justly indebted to Samuel H. Pond as will appear by a note which
 he holds against me due the 1st of January 1834 to John A. Hill for becoming my security to
 James Clayton owner of Miss Sumner's amount not known also to James H. H. Pond for becoming
 my security to John H. Booth owner of Lewis H. Branch amount also unknown believed to be
 due 1840 and whereas the said Benjamin Branch is willing and anxious to secure the said
 Samuel H. Pond John A. Hill and James H. H. Pond. Now this Indenture witnesseth that
 for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said
 Benjamin Branch in hand paid by the said Thugaz Lewis at and before the sealing and delivery
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Benjamin Branch that
 given granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain
 sell to the said Thugaz Lewis his heirs and assigns forever my land or so much of the land
 be remaining in the hands of Andrew Magruder if any after the property shall have been disposed
 of to which said conveying the property he was the trustee or will satisfy the claims against me
 above named which the said Benjamin Branch Conveys to the said Thugaz Lewis his heirs
 and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Thugaz Lewis his heirs and assigns
 and assigns forever and the said Benjamin Branch for himself his heirs and assigns doth hereby
 Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Thugaz Lewis his heirs and assigns forever
 which I will defend against all persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
