Witnesseth That whereas the said Ethelreda Drake in order to secure the payment of a bond due the said John M Hurley bearing equal date with these for the sum of One hundred dollars and 58 Cents and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by the said Saml. S Douglas to the said Ethelreda Drake the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Ethelreda Drake hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel S Douglas all that tract of Land situate in the County of Southampton and adjoining the lands of Edwards Bates and others containing fifty three acres more or less also all my interest in a certain deed of Trust executed by me to Robert Wick for the benefit of Wick and Drury which is of record in the Clerk's Office of the said County. To have and to hold the said tract of Land and all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining together with all my interest in said deed of Trust above referred to unto the said Samuel S Douglas his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever upon trust nevertheless that the said Samuel S Douglas shall as soon as required by the said John M Hurley advertise and sell the aforesaid property after giving due notice of the time and place of such sale first pay the costs attending these premises secondly pay off the debt hereby ^{owed} and thirdly pay the sum plus if any to the aforesaid Ethelreda Drake his heirs or assigns.
