State of Virginia 1821

This Indenture made and executed this 20th day of Nov. A.D. one thousand eight hundred and forty
between Willis W Lawrence and Ann M his wife of the first part of Southampton County a state of Virginia and
Thomas Dunford of the second part of Hampshire County and State of Virginia. Whereas the said
Willis W Lawrence and Ann M his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred dollars
to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged bargained and sold and by these presents
bargain and sell alienate and confirm unto the said Thomas Dunford his heirs and assigns forever one
Cedar tract and parcel of Land lying in Southampton County Va. containing by estimation three hun-
dred and thirty eight acres be the same more or less and is bounded as follows viz. Beginning at
a small copse in the head of the Cedar swamp on the side of the path at the Roofing place near the
late residence of Jacob Darden and thence Eastwardly to a pine a corner in the edge of the fancy
old field thence a Southwardly course to a pine standing on the east side of a small pond thence a
straight line Eastwardly to a small Hickory on the bank of black water river thence down the river
to the mouth of the Cedar swamp thence up the said swamp the various courses thereof to the first
Station it being the tract and parcel of land Jacob Darden recd and Martha Darden recd gave to
their son Septha Darden in the year 1817 and the same tract and parcel of Land the said Willis
W Lawrence bought of Septha Darden and wife. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract and
parcel of Land with the revision and reversion remainder and remainder yearly and other rents
forever the said Willis W Lawrence and Ann M his wife with herby warrant and will forever
defend the aforesaid property unto the said Thomas Dunford his heirs and assigns free from all other
Claims or Claims demand or demands of all and every person whosoever. In Testimony whereof the
said Willis W Lawrence and Ann M his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals
this day and year as is above written.
