Now this indenture witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of One dollar to the said John A Turner in hand paid by the said Saml. P. Douglas at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said John A Turner hath given granted bargained, aliened, released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell aliened release and confirmed to the said Samuel P. Douglas his heirs and assigns forever the following slaves and their increase to wit Jim, Pompey, Fild, Mathew, Dick, Tom, Boston, Phileas, Marshall, Mobey, Chuany — Two bay horses two sorrelly and a light bay household and kitchen furniture of all sorts stock of hogs Corn fodder &c. To have and to hold the said herein before recited property unto the said Samuel P. Douglas his heirs and assigns forever upon Trust nevertheless that the said Samuel P. Douglas shall as soon as he conveniently can after the first day of September next ensuing and having advertised the time and place of sale of the said property by three several advertisements to be posted up at the most public place in the aforesaid County and also by one other advertisement to be posted up at the door of the Court House of said County on some one Court day preceding the day of sale then proceed to sell the same to the highest bidder for ready money and out of the money arising from such sale
