 Sealbrough This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand to eight hundred and forty between Miles Sealbrough and Delilah his wife of the County of Southampton Masters Trustees of the first part James Ellis of the County of Sussex of the second part and John Wothers of the said County of Sussex of the third part and all of the State of Virginia: Whereas the said Miles Sealbrough is justly indebted to the said John Wothers in the sum of One hundred and two dollars and seventy seven Cents lawful money of Virginia to be paid on the fourteenth day of February in the year One thousand eight hundred and forty as by note bearing date on the twelfth day of February in the year One thousand eight hundred and forty well more fully apparent and whereas the said Miles Sealbrough and Delilah his wife is willing and desirous to secure the said debt with its lawful interest to the said John Wothers. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of One dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Miles Sealbrough in hand paid by the said James Ellis at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) they the said Miles Sealbrough and Delilah his wife hath given granted bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff release and confirmed to the said James Ellis his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Pamplton aforesaid and bounded as follows (to wit) On the west and north by the lands belonging to Eli Coker East by Matthew Harris and Miles Jowers land and on the South by the land belonging to Temperance Hines containing two hundred and six acres more or less with all and singular the premises to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the estate right title and interest of them the said Miles Sealbrough and Delilah his wife in and to the said land and other property hereby granted or intended to be granted: To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted land and premises together with the other property above named and hereby
