Wick Esq: to Wick Esq: His Indenture made and entered into on this 9th day of April in the year of our Lord eight hundred and forty one between Matthew Wick and Patience his wife of the County of Southampton and of Virginia of the one part and Sarah Wick of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Matthew Wick and Patience his wife for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars current Money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Sarah Wick at or before the sealing and delivery of this presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold alienated enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do and will of them both grant, bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Sarah Wick his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Lukes containing by estimation twenty six acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of said Sarah Wick and others as follows to wit: Beginning at a sand gap a corner for said Sarah Wick thence his line to a post oak a corner in Benjamin Burns line thence along said Burns line to a dead pine a corner in Christian Jordans line thence his line to a post oak a corner for John Maynard thence his line to a sweet bay standing in a branch a corner for said Sarah Wick thence his line to the beginning together with all right title interest claims or demand of in and to the above described tract or parcel of Land and promising with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and promising with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Sarah Wick his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Sarah Wick his heirs and assigns forever and the said Matthew Wick and Patience his wife for themselves their heirs executors and administrators and each of them doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Sarah Wick his heirs executors and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and promising and every part or parcel thereof against the claiming or demanding of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof the said Matthew Wick and Patience Wick his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
