But a said in the County Court of Southampton of Harrison Parker and infant by Henning
I Smith his executor and next friend agt. Henning I Smith administrator of Maria Parker dec'd.
and Bodwin Parker by Wiley Parker his son and next friend on the 16th November 1840 The
Court ordered that Wiley Parker guardian of Bodwin Parker be directed to sell at public
auction on a credit of six months after having given at least thirty days notice at two
or more public places the land devised by Harrison Parker to his son Bodwin in order that
the decree formally rendered in this cause may be carried into effect and that the purchase
money may be considered as a part of the estate of Harrison Parker to be distributed according
to the directions of said decree and that the same be reported to Court for its final decree
of. Now I the said Wiley Parker do acknowledge that on this 18th of April One thousand
eight hundred and forty one I have received from Henning I Smith Harrison Robt and
Matthew W. Vaughan executors of Harrison Parker under the aforesaid decree the negro boy
Henry to be sold by me and the proceeds to be reported to Court as the decree directs.

This Indenture made this 26th day of July in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty
one between John Drewry of the first part Nancy P. Briggard of the second part and Samuel Drewry
of the third part Whereas the said Nancy P. Briggard on the second day of August in the year of our
Lord eighteen hundred and forty in order to secure the sum of Three hundred and sixty five
dollars and forty four cents to the said Samuel Drewry did by indenture of trust of that date
convey to the said John Drewry his heirs executors &c. a certain tract or parcel of land situate
lying and being in the County of Southampton adjoining the land of David & Walter John Williams
Richard Clements and others containing two hundred and ninety nine acres to the same more
or less upon trust for the purpose
the executing and delivering of the said deed of trust the said Nancy P. Briggard hath fully
satisfied and paid to the said Samuel Drewry the sum of money thereby secured which the
said Samuel Drewry doth hereby acknowledge. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and
the consideration aforesaid as well as for the consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the
said Nancy P. Briggard to the said John Drewry at and before the executing and delivering of
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said John Drewry with the
assent and approbation of the said Samuel Drewry have granted bargained and sold remised
released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell remise release and
confirm unto the said Nancy P. Briggard all the right title and interest which the said
John Drewry and Samuel Drewry have held in the land above described. And the John Drewry
and Samuel Drewry for themselves their heirs executors and administrators the above mentioned
