This Indenture made this twentieth day of March One thousand eight hundred and forty One between Septimus Darden of the first part Robert M. J. Daniel of the second part and Nathaniel Francis of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas the said Septimus Darden is justly indebted to the said Nathaniel Francis in the sum of eight hundred and fifty five dollars to be paid on demand as by bond bearing date the twentieth day of March One thousand eight hundred and forty one more fully appearing which debt together with all other debts for the payment of which the said Nathaniel Francis may be bound for the said Septimus Darden is willing and desirous to secure. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Septimus Darden in hand paid by the said Robert M. J. Daniel at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Septimus Darden he hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell to the said Robert M. J. Daniel his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing One hundred and ninety acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Harriet Whithead Elizabeth Harris Edwin Harris and James Powell also the following slaves and other personal property to wit One negro woman Sarah and child one negro girl Jane Sticks of every description One still and cider casks together with all the household and Kitchen furniture to him the said Robert M. J. Daniel his heirs and assigns forever. Upon Trust nevertheless that if the said Septimus Darden shall will and truly pay to the said Nathaniel Francis his heirs assigns or demand the aforesaid sum of eight hundred and fifty five dollars with the interest thereon and the expenses of this deed together with all other debts aforesaid then these presents are to be null and void and the said Robert M. J. Daniel is hereby required to restore the aforesaid tract of Land together with the negro slaves and the
