Rochelle for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety three dollars twenty seven and a half Cents Current money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said William B. Wilson at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain sold aliened conveyed and confirmed unto him the said William B. Wilson his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land Situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke's containing by a recent survey thirty and one fourth acres to the same more or less it being a part of the tract of Land the said William L. Rochelle inherited from
