 assigns forever the following property to wit three fourteen bush and furniture &c
 bound one walnut table one pine table two chairs bottom chairs six stool chairs
 one clock one cupboard one chest one trunk one board one wheel 2 horses &c increase
 10 head of sheep and increase, 6 head of cattle and increase
 twenty four head of hogs and increase one apple mill two presses twenty seven casks
 1 Southey and Harrope two Carter and wholly farming utensils consisting of
 plows axes grub and weeding hoes &c &c one ground stone three pots and 2 pot
 racks one grindstone one pine woodware consisting of tubs pails &c a parcel of swine
 ware my own growing crop consisting of Corn fodder cotton potatoes peas and apples
 one saddle and bridle with all the right title interest and estate the said Pledge
 Barwood hath in and to the above conveyed property. To have and to hold the above
