he is desirous of securing unto him the said Thomas Drake. Now for and in Consideration
of the premises and the further consideration of One dollar cash in hand paid unto
him the said Archibald Drake by the said James Drake at the entering and
delivery of these presents he the said Archibald Drake hath bargained and sold and
by these presents doth bargain and sell unto him the said James Drake the following
property that is to say all his household and Kitchen furniture including a bedstead and
four tin heads of brass including two broadening saws with their future increase and a
Cart and whiff. On condition nevertheless that the said Archibald Drake shall
retain possession of said property and enjoy the use thereof until such time as he fails
to make payment of the aforementioned debt and in default thereof upon this further
Condition that then the said James Drake shall sell the said property or so much as
will be necessary for the payment of the said debt with the interest thereon accruing
and the expenses of this trust at public auction for cash having previously given
at least ten days notice of the time and place of sale by advertisement at several
public places in the neighbourhood. Now Witness whereof the said parties have
hereunto set their hands and seals this day and date before written.
