Lane and south by the A Jones and Mahomed River that by Benjamin Williamson and north by the said John Bay with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging which right and title I do hereby warrant and defend unto said John Bay his heirs and assigns forever against all Claimants whatsoever.
