 to thousand eight hundred and forty one between John A. Turner and Martha V. his wife of the County
 of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Cathbert D. Barham of the same
 County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said John A. Turner and Martha V. his wife for
 and in consideration of the sum of twenty six dollars and fifty Cents to them in hand paid
 by the said Cathbert D. Barham at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents
 doth grant bargain sell and convey unto him the said Cathbert D. Barham his heirs and
 assigns forever their entire interest in One certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in
 the aforesaid County of Southampton and adjoining the lands of Wm. Pope Williams Esq. John
 John Barham Barton Taylor Simpson & Reese and Cathbert D. Barham containing three
 hundred and six ~~acres~~ ^{acres} be the same more or less together with all the right title interest
 claim or demand of in and to the above described tract or parcel of land and premises
 with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to
 hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular its
 appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Cathbert D. Barham his heirs
 and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said
 Cathbert D. Barham his heirs and assigns forever and the said John A. Turner
 and Martha V. his wife for themselves their heirs Executors ^{and} administrators doth
 hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said Cathbert D. Barham his heirs
 Executors administrators and assigns that they will by these presents warrant
 and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land
 and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the claims or demands of
 all and every person or persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof the said John
