The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Allen Edwards and Louisa his wife have granted bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said David Lewis his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situate lying and being in the County of Southampton from of the property of David Bartholomew and Henry Snow it being a part of real tract that the said Allen Edwards bought of Bartholomew and Henry and bound by the lands of Benjamin Griffin Copeland Turner decedent Broadshaw Milton Hedgepeth and Allen Edwards containing by estimation two hundred and sixty one Acres be the same more or less together with all houses and appurtenances therunto belonging To have and to hold the said land and premises to him and his heirs forever and the said Allen Edwards and Louisa his wife for themselves Their heirs &c. with by these presents conveyed and grant to and with the said David Lewis that he the said Allen Edwards and Louisa his wife against all persons or persons claiming the same parcel or tract of Land will forever warrant and defend.
