Upon trust namely that if the said R^t W^t Daniel shall well and truly pay the aforesaid sum of Eleven hundred dollars with the interest thereon and the expenses of this deed then these presents are to be null and void else the said John P Turner is hereby required to expend the said property to take and out of the premises thereof pay and satisfy the aforesaid debt of Eleven hundred dollars with interest together with the expenses hereof and the surplus if any pay to the said R^t W^t Daniel.
