for the County of Southampton bearing date on the 7th day of April 1841 in the case of
Henry Fowler and others, plaintiffs against Manning T Smith and Jesse Parker administrators
of David S Savage dec^d and Lucius Savage and infant by Elizabeth R Edwards his guardian
relatives defendants, to sell the real estate of the said David S Savage: of the first part
and Orren Vaughan of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and twenty five
dollars paid to the said Edwards Butler Commissioners as aforesaid by the said Orren Vaughan
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby give grant sell and convey to the said
Orren Vaughan his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land in the above
mentioned containing
acres lying and being in the County of
Southampton. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land "called the
estate of David S Savage" being the real estate of the estate said David S Savage to
