This Indenture made the 23rd day of January in the year 1821 between Gary Morrell and Sally
 his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Joseph Turner of the
 same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Gary Morrell and Sally his wife in
 consideration of the sum of One hundred and five dollars of lawful money of the Commonwealth to
 them here hand paid by the said Joseph Turner at or before the sealing and delivery of of these
 presents have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and
 sell unto the said Joseph Turner his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land bounded
 as follows: Beginning at a pine tree in meadow corner of Samuel Corbett and William
 English Thence by a line of meadow trees to a pine tree in the millpond Thence the
 road to a black gum corner between Joel Council and the said Gary Morrell Thence to
 a dogwood corner between the said Gary Morrell Joel Council and Henry Lawrence Thence
 to a pine side line between said Gary Morrell and Henry Lawrence Thence by a line of
 meadow trees to a red oak at the mouth of meadow Thence by the road of meadow to the
 beginning Containing thirty seven and a half acres be the same more or less together with every
 part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said land and premises herein before
 mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every
 of their rights tenements and appurtenances unto the said Joseph Turner his heirs and assigns
 forever. And the said Gary Morrell and Sally his wife for themselves and their heirs the said land
 and premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph Turner his heirs and assigns free from
