This Indenture made and entered into this 10th day of March in the year 1781 between Catharine
Harris of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the one part and David Turner of the same County
and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Catharine Harris for and in consideration of the
sum of ^{three} dollars good and lawful money to her in hand paid by the said David Turner at and
before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged (both
given granted bargained sold and delivered) and by these presents doth give grant bargain
sell and deliver unto the said David Turner to him his heirs and assigns forever all the right
title and interest she the said Catharine Harris is entitled to by virtue of her dower right in and
to each of land formerly belonging to her late husband Benj^a Harris containing two hundred
and seven acres be the same more or less bounded by the lands of Henry Harris James James
Benj^a Turner Est. Rebecca T. Corvett and children and Rebecca Menden which land was sold by
Wm L. Corvett trustee by virtue of a deed in trust executed by said Benj^a Harris to the said
Wm L. Corvett and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton for certain purposes therein
mentioned and the said Catharine not having relinquished her dower as the law directs is now
entitled to the same and with hereby warrant and forever defend the title of said dower right in
and to said land unto the said David Turner his heirs and assigns forever against the claim
and demand of her the said Catharine Harris her and each and every of her heirs and
against the claim and demand of all and every other person or persons whatsoever together with
