To have the aforesaid property in special trust and Consideration to the intent and purpose that if the aforesaid sum of One hundred and fifty one dollar and fifteen cents shall remain unpaid to the said Edward P Turner his heirs executors administrators or assigns shall after giving legal notice expose the aforesaid property to public sale at any time after the first day of November next and with the money arising therefrom first to pay and satisfy the aforesaid sum of One hundred and fifty one dollar and fifteen cents as also the expenses of attending the execution of this Trust and the surplus if any return to me my or my heirs executors administrators or assigns.
