Westbrook both of the same county and state of Virginia in the just and full sum of five hundred and seventy two dollars and 29^{cts} to John Jory due the 20th day of December 1881 due by note bearing date 17th July 1881 and two hundred and thirty dollars and 19^{cts} to Jm D. Westbrook due by note bearing date the 11th day of July 1881 and with intent from date and being desirous and willing to secure the true payment thereof have as well for the aforesaid sum of five hundred and seventy two dollars and 29^{cts} and two hundred and thirty dollars and 19^{cts} as also one dollar to Jm Jones in hand paid by Thos. D. Westbrook trustee the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & the said James Jones have granted bargained and sold by these presents as good bargain and sell unto the said Thos. D. Westbrook the following negro slave Muriel and three children George Anthony and Isabel and Martha and Louisa which is James's children. To have the aforesaid property in special trust and consideration to the intent and purpose that if the aforesaid sum of five hundred and seventy two dollars and 29^{cts} and two hundred and thirty dollars and 19^{cts} shall remain unpaid to the said John Jory and Jm D. Westbrook their heirs executors administrators or assigns shall after giving legal notice from the aforesaid property to public sale at any time after 15 days notice and the with the money arising therefrom first pay and satisfy the aforesaid sum of five hundred and seventy two dollars and 29^{cts} and two hundred and thirty dollars and 19^{cts} as also the expenses of attending that execution of this trust and the surplus if any returns to James Jones or his heirs his heirs executors administrators or assigns For witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the 17th day of July 1881
