Comm^{rs} have granted bargain and sold unto by these presents as given bargain and sell unto William B Goodwyn a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County on the South side of the Three Crooks containing three hundred and sixty four acres to be the same more or less, and bounded as follows: Beginning at A a corner on the Three Crooks between the said William B Goodwyn and the said James Travis N 67° W 118 1/2 poles to a pine a corner to Samuel Drury along his line N 25° E 122 poles to the meadow round the said meadow as it meanders to a run of the Three Crooks N 14° W 22 poles to the main run of the Three Crooks around the said run as it meanders to the beginning, together with all the appurtenances and benefits thereto belonging. To have and to hold unto the said Wm B Goodwyn his heirs and assigns forever which lands with all the appurtenances and benefits thereto belonging the said James Travis and Messrs. in Commissioners, as warrant and forever defend the right and title unto the said Goodwyn his heirs and assigns against the claims of any person or persons whatsoever: For Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this day and year above written.

This Indenture made and entered into this 7th day of May in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty One between Johnson Corbit the seller of the first part Joseph H Johnson the trustee of the second part and Benjⁿ Griffin Creditor of the third part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Whereas the said Johnson Corbit is justly indebted unto the said Benjamin Griffin in the sum of Forty two dollars and three cents of lawful money of this Commonwealth to be paid unto the said Benj Griffin his heirs or assigns on or before the 15th day of August 1841 as by his bearing unto with these presents will more fully appear which debt with the legal interest therefrom the date of these presents the said Johnson Corbit is willing and desirous to secure. This Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar to the said Johnson Corbit in hand paid by the said Jos^{ph} H Johnson trustee at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Johnson Corbit hath given granted bargain and sold unto by these presents as give ground bargain and sell unto the said Joseph H Johnson his heirs and assigns forever One bay Horse two feather beds and furniture five head of sheep four head of horned cattle and thirteen head of hogs with all and singular the right title claim or demand of the above named property hereby conveyed unto the said Joseph H Johnson his heirs and assigns forever and the said Johnson Corbit
